





Dear Mrs. Griffith:

This is to inform you that the remains of your level one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conjucted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the cere and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery vill not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

uncovered with help of French

Slain colonel a hero in town he protected

or more than 50 years. Thomas Griffin, 62, of Fairfax Station wondered what happened to his uncle, Col. Welborn B. Griffith, 42, who was reported killed in France during World War II.

The retired Army lieutenant general only knew his uncle had been killed in action, but he and his family longed for details about how and where Col. Griffith died. The questions drove Gen. Griffin to visit France in 1990 to inquire about his uncle's death, but he came up emptyhanded.

"Everywhere we went, nobody knew anything," he said in a recent interview.

But it turns out that Gen. Griffin and his family, which is spread over the East Coast, were not the only ones looking for answers about his uncle.

Across the Atlantic, residents of Leves, France, often wondered about the brave U.S. soldier gunned down Aug. 16, 1944, during the small town's liberation from German troops. He was the lone American casualty of the battle in the small farm town north of Chartres.

The soldier remained where he fell, as his comrades pursued the fleeing Germans. Within hours, the townspeople of Leves covered the spot with flowers.

Eventually, they put a plaque on a wall at the spot where he was killed, and they turned it into a shrine of sorts, according to recent letters from residents.

On every Aug. 16 since, the town's residents gather at the scene and lay flowers at the memorial of their unknown soldier

morial of their unknown soldier.

But while he was a hero in town folklore, his identity for the past 50 years remained as much of a mystery to the townsfolk as

Col. Griffith's fate remained a mystery to his family.

That's because the townspeople for decades mistook the dead soldier's first name for his last, even commemorating him on the plaque as "Col. Welburn," a misspelled version of his first name.

But Bernard Papillon, a local historian, learned the fallen hero's true identity in the fall with help from officers at the St. Louis facility where U.S. Army personnel records are ware-housed.

Mr. Papillon quickly found Col. Griffith's grave at a French military cemetery, but he and other local residents still wanted to know more about the man who gave his life helping to liberate their town

their town.

So Mr. Papillon put an ad in the Retired Officer Association magazine, asking anyone who knew Welborn Barton Griffith to contact an address in Leves.

When Gen. Griffin saw the ad while sitting in his Fairfax Station home last month, he was "absolutely dumbfounded." He was startled to see it so many years after the family began seeking clues about Col. Griffith's death.

"I always sort of wondered what happened to old Griff; Gen. Griffin said, using the nickname for the uncle he had not seen since he was a young boy. "I really did feel a chill up my spine when I saw that ad."

A series of letters and phone calls to Leves followed and, by mid-March, an excited family knew what had happened to their long-lost relative. And the people of Leves finally satisfied their desire to learn more about their long-anonymous hero.


"I was so thrilled, so very excited," said Col. Griffith's widow, Nel Griffith, 82, from North Carolina. "I was stunned."

"We were just overwhelmed with curiosity. [The ad] was rather eerie," said his daughter,

Alice Irving, 53, in a telephone interview from Jacksonville, Fla. "It was like a voice or a memory from 50 years ago"

According to U.S. Army records and accounts from witnesses in Leves, Col. Griffith was leading a mission to rid the town of German troops that were straggling behind after a Nazi retreat

Although he was the operations officer for 20th Corps headquarters, Col. Griffith load-

ed his rifle and took it on himself to search buildings in town room by room

In the center of town, he found about 15 Nazis and opened fire before jumping atop a U.S. tank and leading a charge at the enemy position, according to witnesses and Army reports.

"During the advance of the

"During the advance of the tank he was exposed to intense enemy machine gun and rocket-launcher fire" and was killed, according to his citation for the

Distinguished Service Cross. The award is this country's second-highest for valor, after the Medal of Honor.

Within hours of Col. Griffith's death, town residents covered his body with flowers and topped it with a small American flag. U.S. troops eventually carted the body away, but residents turned the spot into a makeshift memorial, according to letters townspeople sent to Gen. Griffin.

This Aug. 16, when residents of Leves gather to leave flowers and honor their hero, Gen. Griffin and family will be on hand as official guests of the town. The ceremonies will include dedication of a street in the name of Col. Griffith, a 1925 graduate of West Point.

"It's so nice to know that people really gave a damn," said Gen. Griffin, now the president of D3 International, an engineering firm at 1400 L Street NW.

"They really cared about this fella who came across the ocean to fight and save their town. They just felt he was the savior of their town," he said.

"It really makes you feel good," said Gen. Griffin, a 1956 West Point graduate. "When something like this happens, you have all kinds of emotions stirring inside. They're very loving, very kind people."
